The Malaysian Institute of Estate Agents (MIEA) is the recognised body representing all Registered Estate Agents in the country. Formerly known as the Malaysian Association of Real Estate Agents (MAREA), it was formed in 1974 but officially registered on April 1977 with the Registrar of Societies, Malaysia.

The name "Malaysian Association of Real Estate Agents" (MAREA) was changed to "Malaysian Institute of Estate Agents" (MIEA) on May 3, 1989 to reflect a more professional image of the organisation as it progressed through the years.

Presently, all practicing Estate Agents are required to be registered with the Board of Valuers, Appraisers and Estate Agents, Malaysia in accordance with the Valuers, Appraisers and Estate Agents Act 1981 and they come under the purview of the Ministry of Finance

Guide For Contributors

Articles to be considered for publication are required to adhere to the following guidelines.

Submission of Manuscripts

Manuscripts must be submitted in English. Authors must provide original, unpublished work not under consideration for publication elsewhere. A copy of the manuscript together with original figures and tables must be submitted to the Editorial Board. Manuscripts, figures, tables and disks will not be returned to the author.

All illustrations, figures or tables in the article must be captioned, in clear black and white and ready for reproduction. Illustrations such as maps, pictures, etc must be submitted with a copy of the original photographs and clearly marked and captioned for clear reproduction.

Copyright

Once published in the MASPEX, the copyright including electronic copyrights of the article is automatically vested with MIEA. The copyright covers the exclusive use of rights to reproduce and distribute the article, including reprints, photographic reproductions, microfilm, electronic publication or any reproduction of a similar nature and translations.

MASPEX is an acronym for "Malaysian Secondary Properties Exhibition"
